Hibiscus Tip

Tropical hibiscus have some unique fertilizer needs that are mostly overlooked. Hisbiscus LOVE Potassium (the 3rd number in fertilizer formulas), they just can't get enough of it. However, they HATE Phosphorus (the 2nd number in fertilizer formulas). A frequent mistake people make is using a bloomer booster or superbloom on their hibiscus. This actually causes damage to the plant and will cause the plant to drop its buds and stop producing flowers. If your hibiscus has stopped producing buds or flowers, too much phosphorus or the use of bloom booster are the likely culprits.
